2. RESEARCH METHOD

The purpose of the role of educational professional ethics in building the character of students who are prospective educators, especially prospective Indonesian language teachers, can be studied in the teacher code of ethics, namely: 1) being able to explain and be responsible to the general public, that is part of the basics of ethics, 2) helping experts to facilitate problem solving, 3) as a defense for the reputation of experts, 4) master professional behavior, 5) this is the basis for implementation in accordance with the code of ethics, 6) always maintain the situation with honesty of the profession. A profession is a job that is done for a long time by adhering to one's abilities which are born from the same education as the profession one is undertaking, this job is carried out with full responsibility because it is to earn income. It can be concluded that a profession is a job that is pursued based on education that has abilities and skills in a particular field, which is carried out continuously and full of responsible actions. Professional competence is an ability related to material or teaching materials as a whole, which includes mastery of the substance of the content of the curriculum material for learning subjects at school and the scientific substance that covers the curriculum material, as well as increasing scientific insight as a teacher. The sub competencies and indicators are:

- a) Have knowledge in the field of study being studied and master other related knowledge. This competency has essential indicators: understanding the teaching material in the school curriculum, understanding the structure, concepts and scientific methods that cover or are coherent with the teaching material.
- b) Can master research steps and critical studies to increase insight and deepen knowledge/material in the field of study. As an Indonesian language candidate, students must have a strong determination about their abilities so that they can be confident when applying their knowledge in learning. Students as prospective Indonesian language teachers must also have confidence in what they have learned, so that during the learning process they can help students when they experience problems. difficulties, having sufficient skills to be able to teach effectively, and confidence in increasing students' interest in learning.

The Role of Ethics in Instilling Character Values in Indonesian Language Teacher Candidate Students

A good Indonesian language teacher candidate must have good ethics and personality. As an educator, ethics is very important because it influences how a teacher in the classroom interacts with his students. Therefore, it is very necessary and to instill professional ethics in a teacher. As a prospective Indonesian language teacher, awareness of the application of professional ethics must be a priority. Because ethics is one of the most important aspects that prospective Indonesian language teachers must have. A loyal educational workforce has the right to determine good behavior with this ethic in accordance with applicable norms. So there will be positive things related to human sustainability, such as between teachers and students. This is done so that competency must be achieved by prospective Indonesian language teacher students in educational professional ethics courses by cultivating character values in lectures. This can make the lecturer try to develop the learning outcomes that students will obtain by entering character elements and values. In this section, the lecturer decides several character values that students must implement in their daily lives and be able to apply them as well as possible as prospective Indonesian language teachers. Prioritize values and norms as well as learning ethics, especially in the field of education for prospective Indonesian Language Teachers.
