

## INTEGRATION OF QURAN AND HADITH IN ISLAMIC GUIDANCE METHODS

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**Abstract:** This research is entitled about the integration of the Qur'an and Hadith in the method of Islamic guidance. Of course, the Qur'an and Hadith are the theoretical basis in this research. This research was conducted in order to understand the Qur'an and Hadith as the main guidelines in providing Islamic guidance. The Qur'an is a holy book left by the Prophet Muhammad SAW as a guideline for Muslims. While the Hadith is everything related to the Prophet Muhammad SAW, including his words, deeds, confessions, and circumstances. Hadith is the second source of law in Islam, after the Qur'an. With the Hadith, the Qur'an can be perfected. The Qur'an and Hadith are none other than the main sources of law that cannot be doubted, both have a symbiotic relationship with each other in determining legal dictums. The type of research used is library research. The conclusion is that the integration of the Qur'an and hadith in Islamic guidance methods is very important to provide relevant and effective guidance in helping individuals achieve optimal growth and development.

### Introduction

The Qur'an and Hadith are two holy books that serve as guidelines and instructions for Muslims. The revelations revealed by Allah SWT through the Angel Gabriel (AS) are of two types, namely revelations that are read and revelations that are not read. The revelation that is read is the Qur'an and the revelation that is not read is the Hadith of the Prophet SAW. These two revelations cannot be separated, because they are very closely related. Without the Hadith, there would be many verses in the Qur'an whose meaning and procedures for implementation could not be understood. For example, in the Qur'an Allah SWT commands Muslims to establish prayer and perform the Hajj for those who are able, but the procedures for implementation are not contained in the Qur'an (Ritonga 2023).

Therefore, the Qur'an cannot be practiced properly without an explanation or description of the Hadith of the Prophet SAW. From this it can be concluded that the Qur'an cannot and cannot be separated from the Hadith of the Prophet SAW. The Qur'an and Hadith are the two bases of Islamic law, therefore to understand the essence of Islam, the essence of the Qur'an and Hadith and matters related to both must be understood. This discussion is very important, because it is directly related to the word of Allah SWT which is full of truth, and the words of the Messenger of Allah which are full of wisdom (Ritonga 2023).

The relationship between the Qur'an and Hadith essentially cannot avoid a hierarchy between the two. It has become a common expression among Islamic legal experts that the Al-Qur'an is the first source of law while the Hadith is the second reference source. This order was made at least for the purpose of referring to legal sources in istinbath activities. Before referring to the second source of law, of course the mujtahids first referred to the first source of law. Likewise, after referring to these two main sources, they need to consider the

istidlal mechanism by paying attention to other legal sources such as qiyas, istihsan, maslahah, murlah and others. (Hermawan 2022)

The meaning of guidance, first, guidance is a continuous process, not an instantaneous or coincidental activity. Guidance is a series of systematic and planned stages of activities that are directed towards achieving goals. Second, guidance is "helping" which is identical to "aiding, assisting, or availing", which means that assistance in guidance shows that the active person in developing oneself, overcoming problems, or making decisions is the individual or student himself.

In the guidance process, the mentor does not impose his own will, but acts as a facilitator. The term assistance in guidance can also be interpreted as an effort to create an environment (physical, psychological, social, spiritual) that is conducive to student development, provide encouragement and enthusiasm, develop the courage to act and be responsible, and develop the ability to improve and change one's own behavior. (Moenada 2011)

Integration of the Qur'an and Hadith in Islamic Guidance Methods means completely combining the teachings contained in the Qur'an and Hadith into every process and method of guidance given to a Muslim.

The Qur'an is the last holy book revealed by Allah SWT to His prophets and apostles. This book which was revealed to the Prophet Muhammad SAW is a continuation of previous holy books, such as the Torah which was revealed to the Prophet Moses, the Zabur which was given to the Prophet David, and the Gospel which was revealed to the Prophet Isa. As the final holy book, the Qur'an has a broader function than previous books. This paper tries to examine the function of the Koran for humans. By taking the perspective of the Qur'an and the Islamic religion, research shows that Allah SWT has given the Qur'an a number of names that describe its function. Among them are Al-Huda (guidance), Al-Furqan (differentiator between what is right and what is false), Al-Burhan (proof of truth), Al-Dzikr or Al-Tadzkirah (warning), Al-Syifa (healing medicine), Al -Mau'idhah (advice, lesson), and Al-Rahmah (grace). Apart from that, as the final holy book, the Qur'an also functions as a guide for mankind until the end of time, a complement to previous holy books, and the main source of Islamic teachings brought by the Prophet Muhammad. (Agus Salim Syukran 2019)

The above hadith is in line with the teachings of the Qur'an which emphasizes the importance of knowledge and wisdom, and the Prophet Muhammad SAW stated that seeking knowledge is an obligation for every Muslim. The verse of the Qur'an from Surah Al-Baqarah shows that Allah gives wisdom to whom He wills, and that those who receive wisdom receive many virtues. This shows that knowledge and education are very valuable gifts. (Cindy salsabila guritno, Dwi Nazwa Adisti, and Tiara Rahma Dani 2024) Providing religious advice or guidance is one form of effort to provide assistance to individuals so that their lives are always in line with religious teachings. This effort is a form of motivation so that individuals can increase their enthusiasm for life when facing various trials. This guidance can be in the form of preventive measures or curative measures. (Gazali 2022)

### **Literature Review**

(Dr. M. Quraish Shihab 1996) The Qur'an and Hadith are guidelines for human life that must be obeyed by humans in order to be safe in the world and the hereafter. The Qur'an is a guide for humans to be able to carry out their functions as servants of Allah and caliphs on this earth. Humans who are trained are creatures who have physical and spiritual

elements as well as souls. Intellectual training will produce knowledge, soul training will produce purity and morals, while physical training will produce skills. With this training, creatures will be created who are balanced in worldly life and the hereafter, knowledge and faith.

(KHAIR 2022) The Qur'an and Hadith are two heirlooms left by the Prophet Muhammad SAW as the basis of Islamic education, including as a source of media in Islamic education. For this reason, in this article the author will explain about the Qur'an and Hadith as the Basis of Islamic Education.

(Hibatullah 2022) Islamic guidance and counseling is a process of providing targeted, continuous, and systematic assistance to each individual so that they are able to develop their potential or religious nature optimally by internalizing the values contained in the Qur'an and the hadith of the Prophet Muhammad SAW into themselves, so that they can live life harmoniously and in accordance with the guidance of the Qur'an and hadith.

(Hoirul Anam, Mochamad Aris Yusuf 2022) The Qur'an is a revelation given to the Prophet Muhammad SAW, which aims to be a legal umbrella as well as a guide in carrying out his daily life. The existence of the Qur'an as a guide is not the only alternative for humans to place the Qur'an as a motivator. The goal is none other than so that humans can compete towards positive things in their daily lives. So that the Qur'an discusses all sectors of the needs of all humans. This can be proven that in the Qur'an there are many verses that explain all aspects that can complete the life sector for all mankind, both global instructions and detailed instructions. Both of these things certainly require acceptance of faith, and demand an intellectual approach as a form of endeavor that can function in all things that can lead humans to better goals in accordance with what has been conceptualized by the Qur'an, as well as a form of human improvement to better goals in accordance with what has been conceptualized by the Qur'an, as well as a form of improvement in Education.

(Mufaizin 2018) The Islamic education method is a way or method to achieve educational goals through human activities and efforts in improving the personality of students by fostering the potentials that exist in individuals optimally and as well as possible. The Islamic education method from the perspective of hadith is an educational method in Islam according to the perspective of hadith or an educational method applied and exemplified by the Prophet Muhammad SAW through the hadith narrated from him. The educational methods as applied by the Messenger of Allah in educating and conveying Islamic teachings to his companions (hadith perspective) include, Lecture method, Habituation and punishment method, Dialogue and discussion method (hiwar), Repetition and practice method, Parable method (amtsal), Lecture method, demonstration or exemplary method, story method (story), Targhib and tarhib method, and Mau'izhah method. Prophet Muhammad SAW as a true educator who was chosen by Allah SWT to convey His message, from the beginning he set an example in implementing the correct Islamic education methods for his friends so that educators in the future of his people could emulate them, the learning strategies he used were very precise and accurate, in conveying Islamic teachings he was very attentive to a person's situation, condition and morals, Rasulullah SAW was an ideal and perfect teacher, so that Islamic values could be transferred well and could be accepted by his friends and his people.

## Metode

Research or what is commonly called research is a scientific work activity in order to solve a problem. The results of the research are not intended as a solution or resolution of a

##### **Understanding the Quran**

Etymologically, the Qur'an comes from the word qara -a, yaqra -u, qira'atan or qur'an which means to collect (al -jam'u) and gather (aldhammo) letters and words from one part to another regularly. It is called the Qur'an because it contains the essence of all the books of Allah and the essence of science. Meanwhile, scholars give different opinions regarding the origin of the word al-Qur'an.

The Koran is the holy book of Muslims, it contains the words of Allah Subhanahu Wata'ala which explain His commands and prohibitions and was revealed to the Prophet sallallaahu 'alaihi wasallam as a miracle.

The Koran is the holy book of Muslims which is Kalamullah (the word of Allah), and was revealed to the Prophet through the angel Gabriel to be studied because it brings benefits until the end of time. (Annisa et al. 2023)

The Qur'an is the first and most important source of Islamic teachings according to the beliefs of Muslims and its truth is recognized. The Qur'an is a holy book which contains the words (revelations) of Allah, which were conveyed by the angel Gabriel to Prophet Muhammad as the messenger of Allah continuously and gradually aims to be a guide for Muslims in their lives and livelihoods in order to achieve prosperity in this world and in the hereafter.

The Qur'an is a holy book that is a guide to life for humans which contains warnings or promises in the form of rewards or punishments, but also contains commands. (Baihaqi and Setiawan 2021)

The Al-Qur'an is the word of Allah SWT which was revealed through the Angel Gabriel to the heart of Rasulullah SAW, Muhammad bin Abdullah using Arabic and its correct meaning, so that it becomes a hujjah (dalil) for Muhammad SAW as the Messenger, a law for human life and guidance for people who are guided by him, a means of approaching Allah by reading. It is composed of two mushafs starting with surah al-Fatihah and ending with surah an-Nass which was conveyed to us mutawatir, both in terms of writing and speech, from one generation to another, preserved from various changes and changes, in line. (Fadillah, Mansyur, and Ulya 2023)

##### **Definition of hadith**

Hadith is everything in the form of words, actions, tacit approval, or characteristics attributed to the Prophet Muhammad SAW. Hadith is the second source of Islamic law after the Koran.

Hadith is the second source of Islamic teachings after the Koran. The term hadith usually refers to everything that is denied to the Prophet Muhammad SAW, in the form of

words, actions, agreements, and characteristics (physical or psychological), both that occurred before and after his prophethood. (DJAENUDIN 2021)

The word hadith or Al-hadith according to language means Al-jadid (something new), the opposite of Al-Qadim (something old).

Al-Hadith is also often called "Al-Khabar", which means news, which is something that is discussed and transferred from one person to another. However, scholars have different opinions regarding the clear understanding of hadith.

Scholars of hadith define hadith as follows "all the words of the prophet, his deeds and circumstances". What is meant by matters are everything that is narrated from the Prophet SAW, which is related to his wisdom, characteristics, birth history and habits. There are also those who provide another understanding related to hadith, namely "everything that comes from the Prophet, whether in the form of words, deeds, agreements, physical characteristics and morals, good life path that occurred before the prophet was sent as a messenger such as the compilation of the story in the cave of Hira 'or after". (Syadid 2021)

### **Integration of the Qur'an and Hadith in Islamic Guidance Methods**

Integration of the Qur'an and Hadith in Islamic Guidance Methods means completely combining the teachings contained in the Qur'an and Hadith into every process and method of guidance given to a Muslim.

Guidance is the process of providing assistance in solving problems to someone by giving someone space to be active so they can develop their abilities and be independent.

Guidance is the provision of assistance by a mentor to an individual by providing ideas and freedom to the individual to be active based on existing norms so that the individual can develop themselves.

Islamic guidance is the process of helping individuals achieve spiritual, emotional, and social growth and development based on Islamic values. The Qur'an and Hadith are the main sources in this guidance method because both are guidelines for life for Muslims.

How to Integrate the Qur'an and Hadith in Islamic Guidance Methods

- ❖ **Setting Goals:** The goals of guidance must be in line with the goals of life in Islam, namely achieving happiness in this world and the hereafter.
- ❖ **Analyzing Problems:** Problems faced by individuals are analyzed based on the perspective of the Koran and hadith.
- ❖ **Finding Solutions:** Solutions offered in guidance must be in accordance with Islamic teachings and can be applied in everyday life.
- ❖ **Building Relationships:** Islamic Guidance. Emphasis on the importance of building good relationships with Allah, yourself and fellow humans.

The method comes from the word meta which means through and hodos which means path. The method also comes from German, namely the method which means the teaching of the method, while in Greek the method comes from the word methodos which means path, in Arabic it is called thariq. (Sukandar and Rifmasari 2022)

So the method can be concluded as the way taken to achieve a goal.

The implementation of Islamic Guidance cannot be separated from the Quran and Hadith as its reference sources. In every problem solving there is the sanctity of the verses of the Quran with the theories of Islamic guidance.

Making the Quran as a guide in implementing Islamic guidance is something that is reasonable, because there are 290 verses that have guidance values. Among them are: Quran letter Al-Hijr verses 28-29 which explain the nature of humans in counseling. This verse

explains that humans have two potentials that must be developed, namely material and non-material potential. These two potentials must develop in harmony with the guidance of Islam, namely the Quran. Furthermore, in the letter Al-Ashri verses 1-3 is also the Foundation of Islamic Guidance and Counseling. This verse explains that humans must remind each other, advise each other, educate themselves and also others. The next Counseling Verse is the Quran letter Al-Ahzab verse 72, in this verse the explanation of the function of humans as caliphs on earth. The caliph himself has the meaning as a guide, this is relevant in the counseling process which has a guide, namely a counselor.

In the letter an-Nahl verse 125, 3 methods of guidance are found in order to invite humans to the path of goodness. This is very relevant as a method of Islamic guidance. The three methods of guidance and counseling are as follows:

**a. The Wisdom**

The word al-hikmah according to language has the meaning of knowing the excellence of something through knowledge, perfection, wisdom.

**b. The Greatness of the Universe**

In terms of language, mau'izhah hasanah consists of the words mau'izhah & hasanah. The word mau'izhah means; advice, guidance, education and warning. While hasanah means goodness. In terms, mau'izhah hasanah is one of the manhaj (methods) in inviting to the path of Allah by giving advice or guidance gently so that they want to do good.

**c. Ahsan's Mujadalah**

In Indonesian mujjadi is often edited by arguing or discussing. Arguing is spinning your mind by comparing the reasons of both parties.

In a hadith narrated by Bukhari it is said:

حديثنا مصداق حديثنا معتمير عن حميد عن انسي رضي الله عنه قال: قال رسول الله صلى الله عليه وسلم: صور اخافه ظالما او مظلوما. قالوا: يا رسول الله هذا ننصره مظلوما فكيف ننصره ظالما؟ قال: تأخذ فوق يديه

"Said Musaddad, had said the Congress from Hamid, from Anas ra, said Rasulullah SAW: "Help your brother whether he is an unjust person or an oppressed person." They asked: "O Messenger of Allah, it is true that we help people who are wronged, but how do we help people who are wrong?" The Apostle answered: "Forbid him to do injustice." (HR. Bukhari).

From the hadith above, it is seen that the target of providing assistance is the oppressed or the person who is in trouble. Likewise, the target is the person who is forgetful and is doing injustice to others. The role of the counselor is to return him to his position as a faithful Muslim, who implies peace and tranquility. This is then the main goal in the Islamic consultation discussion process.
