The Nature Of Teacher In Islamic Education

Definition of Rural Touris

In English, there are found several words for the title of teacher, namely "teacher, tutor, educator, and instructor. All of these words are close to the teacher's title. In Webster's dictionary, a teacher is interpreted by someone who teaches, a tutor means a teacher who teaches students, a private teacher instructor, is interpreted as someone who has the responsibility of educating others. The term teacher in Arabic, found the words ustadz, muddaris, mu'alim, mu'addib ,. The word ustadz means teacher, professor (academic degree), intellectual level, trainer, writer, the word muddaris means teacher, instructor (instructor) and lecturer (lecturer). Furthermore, the word mu'allim means teacher (teacher), instructor (trainer), trainner (guide), and the word mu'adib means educator (teacher) or teacher in Koranic School (teacher in an educational institution). In Indonesian, the teacher comes from a string of words people are digugu and imitated. Teachers in Indonesian are also called educators. Experts define the word teacher or educator as follows:

1. ZakiyahDarajat, defines the teacher (educator) as a professional educator, so implicitly he has volunteered himself to accept and assume the responsibility of education that shouldered on the shoulders of parents.

2. Ramayulis, believes that the teacher (educator) is the person who bears the responsibility to guide students to become humane human beings.

3. Ahmad Tafsir, defines, the teacher (educator) is a person who is responsible for the ongoing process of growth and development of the potential of students, both cognitive and psychomotor potential.

From the above definition it can be said that the teacher is someone who carries out his main task, namely educating, directing, teaching, guiding, and evaluating his students in education.

Teacher Requirements (educator)

In Law No. 20 of 2003 and PP RI No. 19 of 2005 Chapter VI concerning the standards of Educators and Education Personnel includes the requirements to become a teacher as contained in article 28, namely:

1. Teachers must have academic qualifications and competencies as agents of learning, healthy, physical and spiritual, and have the ability to realize national educational goals.

2. Academic qualifications as referred to in paragraph 1 the minimum level of education that must be fulfilled by a teacher as evidenced by a relevant diploma and / or certificate of expertise in accordance with applicable laws and regulations.

3. A person who does not have a diploma and / or certificate of expertise as referred to in paragraph (2) but has special expertise that is recognized and required can be appointed as a teacher after passing the feasibility and health tests. The task of the teacher is a central figure in delivering humans (students) to noble goals. Khoe Yoe Tung, said that teachers are the spearhead as well as a key factor in improving the quality of education and the development of human resources. In Islamic education the main task of the teacher according to Imam al-Ghazali is to perfect, cleanse, purify, and bring the human heart to bertaqarrub to Allah SWT

because education is an effort to draw closer to Allah. The teacher in the education institution is a continuation of the mandate received from parents and helps to develop and develop all the basic potentials possessed by students properly and correctly to the maximum extent. Teacher position

The position of the teacher in society has now begun to decline, incompatibilities between conditions have begun to decline, incompatible between actual conditions and ideal conditions in their lives. Teacher's dignity began to decline in the eyes of the community. The lack of teacher's dignity in the eyes of society today is caused by several things, namely,

1. Take the example from within some teachers, even though the teacher must be a model, uswatun hasanah for their students.

2. Because of the influence of the views of materialism, and pragmatism.

3. Materialistic societies look down on the position of the teacher because they look down on the position of someone is determined by how much wealth or property a person has.

Al-Ghazali subsequently quoted several traditions of the Prophet about the virtues and positions of the teacher. He concluded that teachers are referred to as great people whose activities are better than a year of worship. Furthermore, al-ghazali menukilkan from the words of the cleric which states that from the words of the cleric which states that the teacher is the lamp of all ages, people who live during it will get the light (nur) of his knowledge. In Islamic education the teacher is referred to as Abu al-muh or Spiritual Father, or spiritual father for students to provide spiritual nourishment with knowledge and fostering noble morals. When viewed in Islamic education based on the Qur'an and the hadith of the Prophet Muhammad we will find a very high position. The Qur'an elevates the ranks of people who have knowledge. The Word of Allah SWT Q.S al-baqarah verse 269, meaning "Allah bestows Al wisdom (a deep understanding of the Qur'an and Sunnah) to whom he wills. And whoever is blessed with wisdom has truly been blessed with many gifts. And only those who are blessed can take lessons (from God's word). Above is seen how high the position of the teacher is also very honored and noble.

The role of the teacher in the teaching and learning process, in the teaching process the role of a teacher is very significant in the teaching and learning process. The role of the teacher in the teaching and learning process includes many things such as instructors, class managers, supervisors, motivators, consulators, explorers, and so on.
